



## WORK EXPERIENCE

We are able to provide placements for those over the age of 15 who wish to organise their own work experience but we do receive a large number of applications and unfortunately can't accommodate everyone.

Because of the competition for places we can only provide one week per student and we only accept those who are genuinely considering a career in Veterinary Medicine. If your area of interest lies within other areas of animal work such as equine science or physiotherapy, we suggest that you should seek work experience in these areas rather than at a veterinary practice.

The placement is organised so that you split your time into four blocks within the week learning about our small animal practice, our equine practice, our farm practice and the general administration of the practice.

Those on work experience are learning about life in a professional environment and are meeting our clients and staff so it is very important that those applying are good at communicating with others. Smart dress is mandatory. You should bring wellies and protective clothing (e.g. waterproofs or boiler suit) and wear smart clothing and sensible non-slip shoes (ideally steel-toe capped). Jeans and trainers are not allowed!
