## JOB PURPOSE SUMMARY

At The George Veterinary Hospital, we expect our Veterinary Care Assistants to:

- Support and assist the nursing staff in the care of all hospitalised and day patients.
- Be responsible for the cleanliness and organisation of the kennels, cattery and Wendy House
- Make sure that all patients are as comfortable as possible at all times

## KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Communicating effectively with veterinary surgeons, clients, colleagues and other members of the veterinary team both verbally and written
- 2. Assisting in the running of the Hospital Wards– i.e. feeding, walking and restraining patients under the instruction of the veterinary surgeon/veterinary nurse.
- **3. Preparation of Equipment, Patient and Environment** ready for patient hospitalisation or the examination of patients.
- 4. General cleaning duties of all clinical areas, equipment, sterilisation and laundry
- **5. Basic handling and restraint of patients** to assist the nurses and vets with examinations, blood sampling, scanning, bandaging, grooming, and general patient care.
- 6. Ordering- Lab equipment, cremation equipment and other consumables, from appropriate suppliers.
- 7. Assisting vets in consultations and maintaining consults room, including stock control and infection control
- **8. Performing diagnostic tests on laboratory samples** communicating and recording results following practice policy and preparing samples to be sent to external laboratories
- 9. Adherence to Regulations i.e. Health and Safety, COSHH (refer to specific guidelines)
- **10. Assisting other departments within the Veterinary Practice** e.g. reception duties and large animal kits
- **11. Arrange the collection of ashes** following practice protocol, ensure ashes are sent to the correct surgery and arrange collection with the client
